



Target: 75-90% of new residential units to be located in 4 key centres

#### Anticipated growth under OCP

- 30,000 45,000 square feet of additional institutional uses such as child care, adult daycare, youth centre, community art and cultural space and programmable community multi-purpose spaces
- 160,000 square feet of additional retail and service uses
- 25,000 additional square feet of office

- Reinforce the crossroads as the historic/future civic centre of activity
- Create a vibrant streetoriented shopping district & High Street
- Create a community size park for active play
- Connect with fine-grained mobility network
